A highly valued and essential part of any Health and Wellbeing program.

According to Cancer Australia, it is estimated that a person has a 5.6% (1 in 17) risk of being diagnosed with melanoma of the skin by age 85.

These statistics are sobering; and highlights the importance of why skin checks are vital for early detection to reduce the potential impact on employees and your organisation. Offering skin checks works towards a culture of care, and in many cases, particularly with outdoor workers, may be an OH&S obligation.

Our skin checks are expertly performed by a Dermoscopist Skin Specialist Nurse using a dermatoscope. The dermatoscope allows for a clear and deep view into pigmented lesions enabling skin irregularities to be identified and ultimately to the early detection of melanoma.



Service types:

All areas of examinations are at the discretion of the employee.

Standard Check 15 minute

A detailed full body examination.

Express Check 10 minute

Examines the commonly exposed areas of the body.
